The grand finale was the event organised by the children and young people to raise money for their chosen charity.

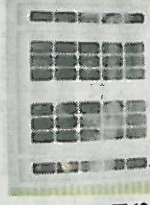

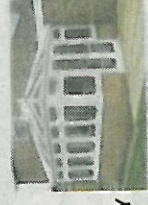

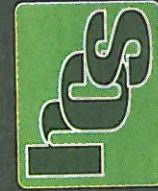
